Chamomile

Chamaemelum nobile



General Information

- Perennial flower
- Sun Exposure: Full sun to partial shade
- Water needs: Low
- <u>Temperature</u>: Thrives at temperatures between 60-65 °F. Can tolerate cold well.
- Bloom season: Summer

Planting Guide

- Planting Season: Spring
- Location: Plant in full sun with average, well-draining organic soil.
- Compost: No compost needed at planting.
- Spacing: Plant 8-10 inches apart from each other.

Care Guide

- <u>Irrigation</u>: Water the plant frequently after planting until maturation around 1 inch per week. Once matured, water only once the underlayer of soil begins to dry. You can check by sticking a finger into the soil and feeling for moisture.
- <u>Supplemental Fertilizer</u>: You can add a small amount of fertilizer to the plant during the Spring before blooming, but this is unnecessary.
- <u>Pests</u>: Chamomile is generally pest-resistant. Just make sure to water enough to keep the plant healthy.
- <u>Diseases</u>: As long as the plant is watered appropriately, the chamomile is fairly disease-resistant.
