Thyme Thymus vulgaris





General Information

- Edible herb
- <u>Sun Exposure</u>: Full sun
- <u>Water needs</u>: Low
- <u>Cold Tolerance</u>: Tolerates cool to cold temperatures, lowest being freezing.
- Days to harvest: 14 to 28 days after planting.
- <u>Harvest season</u>: Summer

Planting Guide

- <u>Time</u>: Plant in early spring, two to three weeks before the last frost date.
- Location: Plant in well drained soil with other drought-tolerant perennial plants.
- Spacing: Space plants 12 to 24 inches apart from each other.
- <u>Mulching</u>: Mulch only if the weather becomes very cold in the fall or winter, and remember to remove mulch once spring comes.

Care Guide

- Irrigation: Water deeply only when soil is completely dry
- <u>Pruning</u>: Prune during the spring and summer to maintain their growth and spread.
