

Thyme

Thymus vulgaris



General Information

- Edible herb
- Sun Exposure: Full sun
- Water needs: Low
- Cold Tolerance: Tolerates cool to cold temperatures, lowest being freezing.
- Days to harvest: 14 to 28 days after planting.
- Harvest season: Summer

Planting Guide

- Time: Plant in early spring, two to three weeks before the last frost date.
- Location: Plant in well drained soil with other drought-tolerant perennial plants.
- Spacing: Space plants 12 to 24 inches apart from each other.
- Mulching: Mulch only if the weather becomes very cold in the fall or winter, and remember to remove mulch once spring comes.

Care Guide

- Irrigation: Water deeply only when soil is completely dry
- Pruning: Prune during the spring and summer to maintain their growth and spread.
